

Lesson 10

Parts of the Human Body

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This lesson is a typical beginner's lesson intended to help with the learner's vocabulary. In order to help the learner with the pronunciation, we will mark the tones on each syllable. The following tone-marking convention will be adopted: High tones will be left unmarked. Low tones will be marked with a grave accent (`). Step tones will be marked with a macron (¯).
